Laurieston Phase 2 (Traffic Regulation) Order 20__

Glasgow City Council proposes to consider the introduction of the above named Traffic Regulation Order in terms of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

As part of the Laurieston Phase 2 housing development, it is considered necessary to implement 'No Waiting and No Loading at any time' restrictions throughout the development in order to reduce the risk of hazardous and inconsiderate parking due to the anticipated increase in volume of traffic in the area.
