GENERAL WORKS UPDATE

The focus of the works is now on the final section which is the woodland and local nature reserve and its surroundings. In the woodland area new paths are being delivered along the key routes into and out of the woods.

To the south of the woodland, works are ongoing to install new street lighting and a 3m wide tarmac path between Toryglen and Burnhill.

There is also a new play area being created on the hill near Prospecthill Crescent. Further new routes will be created leading to and from this to connect it into the wider network.

New boulders with nature-themed artwork have recently been put in place around the woods, how many can you find?




MALLS MIRE NATURE RECORDING
